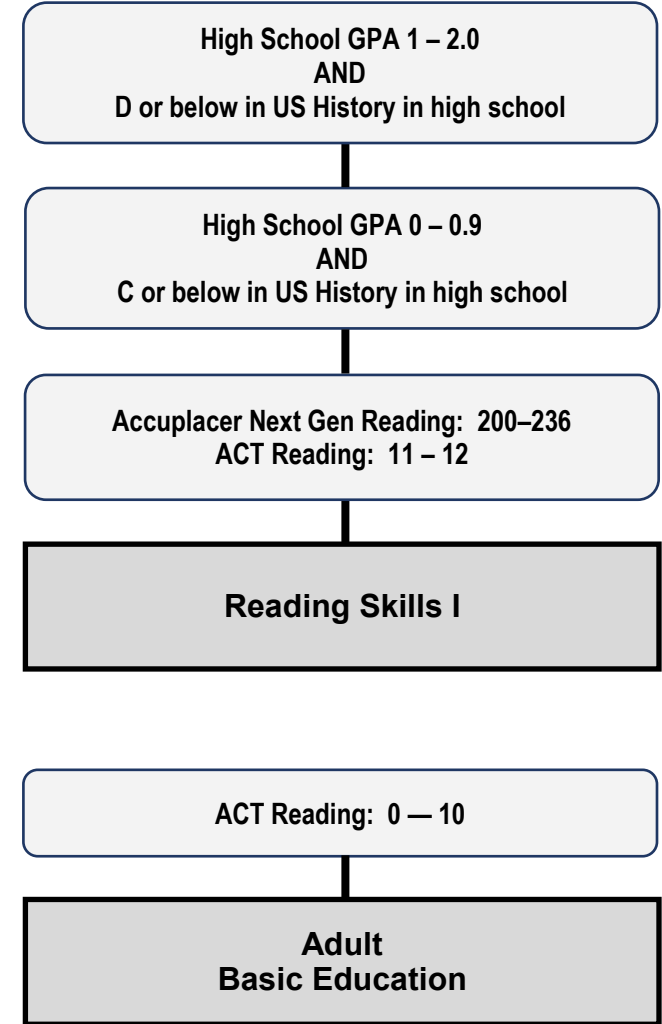
READING COURSE PLACEMENT MATRIX
